ORDER

Before the Court is the motion of Defendant NameMedia, Inc. (“NameMedia”) to Alter Time for Filing of Rule 11 Motion for Sanctions (Doc. 4) and its Corrected Motion to Alter Time for Filing of Rule 11 Motion for Sanctions. (Doc. 6).
