We received your email with the attached complaint. Pursuant to Rule 4(i)(1) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, a summons and complaint against a federal agency must be served on both the United States and the agency. The instructions for serving the United States are set forth in Rule 4(i)(A)(i) and (ii). The instructions for serving the agency, in this case, the Federal Communications Commission, are set forth in Rule 4(i)(2). Again, you must serve the FCC with both a summons and Complaint. The rule provides that service must be by registered or certified mail, however, we are willing to accept your summons and complaint by regular mail. The email that you sent with the attached complaint, however, does not constitute service because it does not have a summons. While the FCC is willing to accept service by regular mail, we can not speak for the Department of Justice. I just listened to CBS v FCC oral argument made by Jacob Lewis Esq. I heard Robert-Corne Revere Esq repeatedly cite Pacifica as "under Pacifica" as if it were a statute and not just an archaic interpretation of statute.
