**AMENDED NOTICE OF APPEAL OF ORDER DOCKET 97
AND ORDER DOCKET 126 DISMISSAL PER THE
COLLATERAL ORDER DOCTRINE**

The collateral order doctrine is a narrow exception to the final-judgment rule and the collateral order doctrine makes not allowing the issues of Lanham Act violations and Title 17 violations due to pled limitations defense as well as Summary Dismissal of Network Solution LLC to each be collateral rulings too important to the claim and too independent of the permitted defamation claim for an appellate decision to be deferred until the entire case is adjudicated. Therefore, this interlocutory appeal is warranted as supported more specifically in the concurrently filed supporting brief. The Network Solution LLC dismissal was incorrect and failure to grant equitable tolling was abuse of discretion that resulted in a violation of a right to trial by jury as established in the Sixth Amendment. Plaintiff begs the Eighth Circuit to remand or otherwise overrule.
