Thank you for your email.

I had the opportunity to review the entire document you sent me this morning. Again, I am sorry for the loss of your domain name, however as I have previously stated the domain name was not renewed, and was sent back to the registry.

In researching Ican's website further I did find the following statement: ICANN requires accredited registrars to collect and provide free public access to the name of the registered domain name and its name servers and registrar, the date the domain was created and when its registration expires, and the contact information for the Registered Name Holder, the technical contact, and the administrative contact. We are mandated by ICANN to follow the guidelines that they set forth for all domain name registrars.

Due to the fact that you state you have a Trademark on the name, you do have the option of filing a UDRP (Uniform Domain Resolution Policy) with ICANN. I am including a link for you.
